DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR REGISTRATION OF MINOR CHILDREN
—SECTION 8(1)

1. Two Form 8 forms as contained in the First Schedule of the Citizenship Regulations made pursuant to the Citizenship Act, Chap. 1:50 obtainable at the Ministry of National Security, Port-of-Spain. These forms must be completed by the applicant and signed in the presence of a Commissioner of Affidavits.
2. A non-refundable fee of \$50.00 payable at the Ministry of National Security. The total fee is \$320.00. The balance shall be payable when the application is approved.
3. Birth Certificate. If correct name, etc., does not appear on the Birth Certificate, then an Affidavit sworn to by a person who knows of birth, namely, parents, elder siblings or older relatives must be submitted—Original and Photocopy.
4. Recommendation from a citizen of Trinidad and Tobago. Persons suitable for acceptance as recommenders are Members of Parliament, Mayors, Chairmen, Councillors or Aldermen of City, Borough and Regional Corporations, Justices of the Peace, Ministers of Religion, Medical or Legal Practitioners, Established Civil Servants—Range 30 and above, Bank Managers, Registered Teachers, Police Officers—Corporal and above or any person of similar standing.
5. Three (3) identical passport size photographs. The recommender is required to endorse the reverse side of one copy of the photograph with the words **“I certify that this is a true likeness of (Mr./Mrs./Miss)...”** and add his/her signature.
6. Applicant’s Registration Certificate. (Responsible parent or guardian).
